Powers and Functions of the Committee

- (a) The SLSC is mandated to finalise the list of schemes for implementation under the BADP and to approve the Annual Action Plan for submission to the Department of Border Management, Ministry of Home Affairs. The Chairman of the SLSC may co-opt members on the Screening Committee such members, considered as necessary to facilitate deliberation/decision making in the SLSC.
- (b) The SLSC shall meet at least twice in a year in the month of February/March to finalise and approve the schemes recommended by Block Level Committees / District Level Committees. The finalised Annual Action Plan to be communicated to the Department of Border Management, Ministry of Home Affairs, Govt. of India by mid April.
- (c) The 2<sup>nd</sup> meeting of the SLSC may preferably be held in November/December to review the progress under the BADP, submission of utilization certificate and quarterly progress report etc.
