NOTIFICATION

In cancellation of earlier Notification No. BD. 60/99/91 dated 31st July, 2000, the Governor of Assam is pleased to constitute the District Level Committee (DLC) in respect of the Border Blocks of Indo-Bangladesh Border as well as Indo-Bhutan Border for selection of schemes of Border Areas Develoment Programme under Special Central Assistance and such committee will comprise with the following Members:-

District Magistrate

: Chairman.

Divisional Forest Officer (T) in the district 2.

: Member

3. Senior Planning Officer of the district

Member-convenor

Superintendent of Police of the concerned District 4

Member

Commandant or Deputy Commandant of the Border Guarding Force : Member 5. Present in the district.

Powers & Functions of the Committee

- The DLC shall prepare village-wise plans through a Base Line Survey of the villages in the Blocks. It will access the gaps in the existing physical and social infrastructure sectors and work out the over arching sectoral priorities, within which the various Department schemes will be selected in a systematic manner according to the need/gan.
- (b) The DLC shall ensure that there is no overlapping of the schemes taken up under BADP with that of other ongoing schemes of Central Government /State Plan and give Certificate to the effect while submitting the Annual Action Plan (AAP) to the Government.
- The DLC shall look into the convergence with on-going development programmes and (c) schemes of different Ministries / Departments of Central/ State Government and funds coming through various channels for the well being of the people.
- The DLC shall have consultation with the local Member of Parliament, MLA, Members of (d) PRIs, Autonomous Councils, Community Leaders and Development Agencies to know the felt-needs of the people and take final decisions keeping in view the people's priorities and its own assessment for bridging the gaps in public infrastructure and services for selection of works within the overall sectoral priorities.
- The DLC shall ensure that no scheme below the estimated cost of Rs. 5.00 lakh is (e) included in the AAP of the BADP.
- After approval of the schemes by the Committee, the Deputy Commissioners will submit the schemes to the Director of Border Areas, Assam.
- The Director of Border Areas after necessary examination/scrutiny will submit the schemes to the Government for approval of the State Level Screening Committee (SLSC).
- The DLC shall take responsibility of monitoring of implementation of works under BADP as well as quality of works and submit a report on quarterly basis to Border Areas Department/ Director, Border Areas.

The Notification is issued as per Revised Guidelines of BADP (February, 2014) issued by Ministry of Home Affairs, Department of Border Management.
